Subject: Online Telecommunications/Internet Access Aid Cost Reporting – FY 2017 Actual Costs

Deadline: February 28, 2018

This memo is to notify you that the online website for schools and telecommunication clusters is open for data collection of Fiscal Year (FY) 2017 cost and E-Rate data. **The deadline for data submission is February 28, 2018**. Remember that this is a reimbursement program and you are reporting **Actual FY 2017** Cost data both before and after E-Rates. The costs you report after E-Rates will be used to calculate your school's amount for Telecommunications/Internet Access Equity Aid paid in FY 2018.

The Sharepoint data entry process has changed for all districts and clusters. To begin the process, the district must send an email to Lonn Moe (Lonn.Moe@state.mn.us). Lonn will copy the email address to the Sharepoint365 invitation page and send it. You will then be able to accept the invitation and access Sharepoint365. Access the new login to the Online Telecommunications/Internet Access Aid Cost Reporting system (https://mn365.sharepoint.com/sites/MDE/Telecomm/default.aspx).

After you have successfully logged in, Instructions and Program Criteria (a Word document containing additional program information) will be visible on your screen. The Program Criteria document will provide answers to many of your questions. Carefully review both items before attempting to submit data.
