AMENDED RESOLUTION WAIVING THE “POSTING REQUIREMENT” FOR INTERNAL HIRES SEEKING AN OUT-OF-FIELD PERMISSION

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board is responsible for maintaining licensing standards and requirements for teachers and related services providers in Minnesota.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Rules part 8710.0320 authorizes a teacher holding a Tier 2, Tier 3, or Tier 4 license to teach in a field not aligned with the license held by obtaining an out-of-field permission.

WHEREAS, an out-of-field permission is valid for one year and may be renewed up to four times.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Rules part 8710.0320, subpart 2 establishes requirements for a teacher seeking an out-of-field permission, including a requirement that the hiring district post the position on the statewide job board for 15 days prior to offering the position to the teacher.

WHEREAS, Minnesota Rules part 8710.0320, subpart 4 establishes requirements for a teacher seeking to renew his/her out-of-field permission, including a requirement that the hiring district post the position on the statewide job board for 60 days prior to offering the position to the teacher.

WHEREAS, the posting requirement creates an extra step for Minnesota districts that know they are interested in having an internal hire fill the position.

WHEREAS, the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board has the authority to waive its rule requirements pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 14.055.

WHEREAS, the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board resolved to waive the posting requirement for internal hiring seeking to renew their out-of-field permission on March 8, 2019.

WHEREAS, I, Brian Rappe, certify that I am a member and the Chair of the Minnesota Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board, a board authorized under the laws of the State of Minnesota; that the following is a true, complete, and correct copy of a resolution that the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board adopted at a properly convened meeting on April 12, 2019; that a

quorum was present; and that a majority of those present voted for the resolution, which has not been rescinded or modified.

THEREFORE, the Board resolved the following:

The “posting requirement” for internal hires seeking an out-of-field permission is waived until Minnesota Rules part 8710.0320 is opened and revised by the board.
